### Samvedana The Follow up Magic

Babarao Dhawak, age 66, from Kajna village, Tq. Nandgaon district Amravati, shared his experience, In rural areas, it is very common to ignore ordinary health issues by bearing the pain. Even though he had prior kidney issues, he also did the same thing in case of back pain and fever. Aggravating the situation made him approach Dr. Hedgewar Hospital, Amravati, remembering past pleasant treatment experiences along with an observation that a patient is never held back here for money. Treatment initiated under the supervision of Dr. Mansi Kavimandan, starting with lumber puncture. After investigations, the T.B. was declared. After a small course of accurate treatment, he was relieved and went home contented.

He also mentioned that people from his village had lost all hope for his survival. However, Dr. Bodhankar and his teams positive and energizing approach during his primary consultation helped restore his faith and determination to fight against the illness.

Dhavak's treatment cost INR 35,690, but our PPF Poor Patient Fund lowered it to INR 16,409, ensuring his care without financial strain. We take pride in the steps we are taking to encourage Indian rural communities to prioritize health through our outreach and follow-up infrastructure.
